ARE YOU 65 OR OLDER?

Hamilton ISD residents 65 and older with an applicable over-65 exemption have their HISD tax bill frozen at their freeze ceiling. Your tax bill can go down but it can never go above your ceiling. Future property appraisal increases or tax rate increases will NOT increase your bill above your ceiling. However, significant improvements to your existing homestead can affect your bill. DID YOU KNOW?

The HISD tax rate has decreased 43 cents from 2014. In 2014, the tax rate was \$1.18 and has steadily decreased since 2019.

The current rate is **75 cents.**

If the bond passes, the new tax rate would be **98 cents.**

The majority of the taxable value in HISD is industry such as solar, oil & gas, and businesses.

AND DID YOU KNOW?

The I&S tax (bond) dollars are **solely dedicated** to HISD. The state is prohibited from using HISD bond tax dollars for state funding purposes.

BALLOT LANGUAGE

THE ISSUANCE OF \$19,800,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, IMPROVEMENT, ACQUISITION, EXPANSION, AND EQUIPMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING REPAIR AND RENOVATION TO ROOFS, ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL, AND GYMNASIUMS, INCLUDING NECESSARY SITES, AND THE PURCHASE OF NEW SCHOOL BUSES, AND THE LEVYING OF A TAX SUFFICIENT, WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT, TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST OF THE BONDS AND TO PAY THE COSTS OF ANY CREDIT AGREEMENTS EXECUTED OR AUTHORIZED IN ANTICIPATION OF, IN RELATION TO, OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE BONDS; THIS IS A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE.
